





Call for Applications: EU SUMMER SCHOOL 2020

COVID-19: Economic development, environmental sustainability and the emergence of global pandemics

21 - 23 September 2020

The EU Summer School is organized by the European Young Cell Alumni Kosovo in cooperation with the Young Cell Scheme (Round XI-XII) project and the University of Prishtina 'Hasan Prishtina'. Considering the unprecedented situation caused by the pandemic COVID-19 and its economic, social and environmental effects, the EUSS 2020 will focus on two main streams:

- **4** Environmental drivers behind emergence of global pandemics;
- **4** Economic development and environmental degradation.

Professors from *Maastricht University, Uppsala University, KTH Royal Institute of Technology, University of Prishtina,* experts from the *World Health Organisation, UNDP and the EU Office in Kosovo,* as well as *Young Cell Alumni,* who completed their master's studies in top European universities and who are currently engaged in the civil service in Kosovo, will lecture on different topics related to the two main themes.

The EUSS 2020 will be organised **online** and in total here will be 13 lectures over the course of 3 days. At the end of the third day a recap session will be held covering everything that has been discussed over the entire programme.

Each participant who successfully attends the entire EUSS 2020 will receive an attendance certificate. In addition to students, participation is also open to graduates who are interested in the topic of EUSS 2020.



WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Students from all public and private universities across Kosovo, enrolled in bachelor or master studies. Students constitute the primary target of the school, nevertheless those who graduated but show an interest in the topic may also apply.

All participants will be awarded an attendance certificate.

Requirements:

- Preferably, their field of studying/expertise should be related to: Public Health, Environmental Studies, Development Studies, Economics, Agriculture, Biology, Geography or other social and natural sciences.
- At least B1 or B2 level of communication in English is required (spoken and listening).













This edition of the European Summer School 2020 will be held **online**. Details will be shared with those who express an interest to participate in the EUSS 2020.



WHEN IS IT?

The European Summer School 2020 will be held between the **21** and **23 September 2020.** Courses are scheduled in two sessions. Details can be found in the programme.
