UNIVERSITY AUTONOMY AND INTEGRITY

PURPOSE

EUTOPIA - European University is a project of six European universities (University of Ljubljana - coordinator, CY Cergy-Paris Universite, Vrije Universitat Brussels, Gothenburg University, Pompeu Fabra University and Warwick University) financed out of a new EC programme. The project aims to develop new ways of in-depth collaboration between European universities seeking synergy and innovation in the fields of education, research, collaboration with regional and industrial partners, social inclusion function of universities and internationalisation. One of its most prominent work packages is focused on enhancing the circulation of knowledge between the EUTOPIA universities and the universities of the neighbouring regions. This activity will be realised in the form of six workshops to be delivered in the period 2020 - 2022.

The first workshop was focused on research and the second on curricula design. The purpose of the third workshop is threefold. Firstly, it aims at the exchange of experiences with and views about the university autonomy and integrity between the EUTOPIA and regional universities. Secondly, it tries to raise the awareness that higher university autonomy requires higher attention to the integrity issues. The third purpose is to put the issue of university autonomy into the contemporary context where there is an increasing accent on partnership of universities with their stakeholders.

DURATION AND OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The duration of the workshop is two days for up to three hours each. Considering this is an international event, the official language of the event will be English. After the event, participants will receive copies of PowerPoint presentations.

This event is primarily intended for Western Balkans universities' representatives responsible for education: rectors, vice rectors for education, directors of education/ curricula planning supportive services, as well as student representatives.
